<sup>3</sup> There are no two-hour electives in English. Choose 2 one-hour electives or 1 three-hour elective.

<sup>4</sup> Upper level perspectives (ULPs) may NOT be courses in English. There are no exceptions.

<sup>5</sup> This eighteen-hour semester is a suggestion in order to allow for a twelve-hour semester during Internship II while still fulfilling 120 hours. All coursework must be completed before Internship II.
