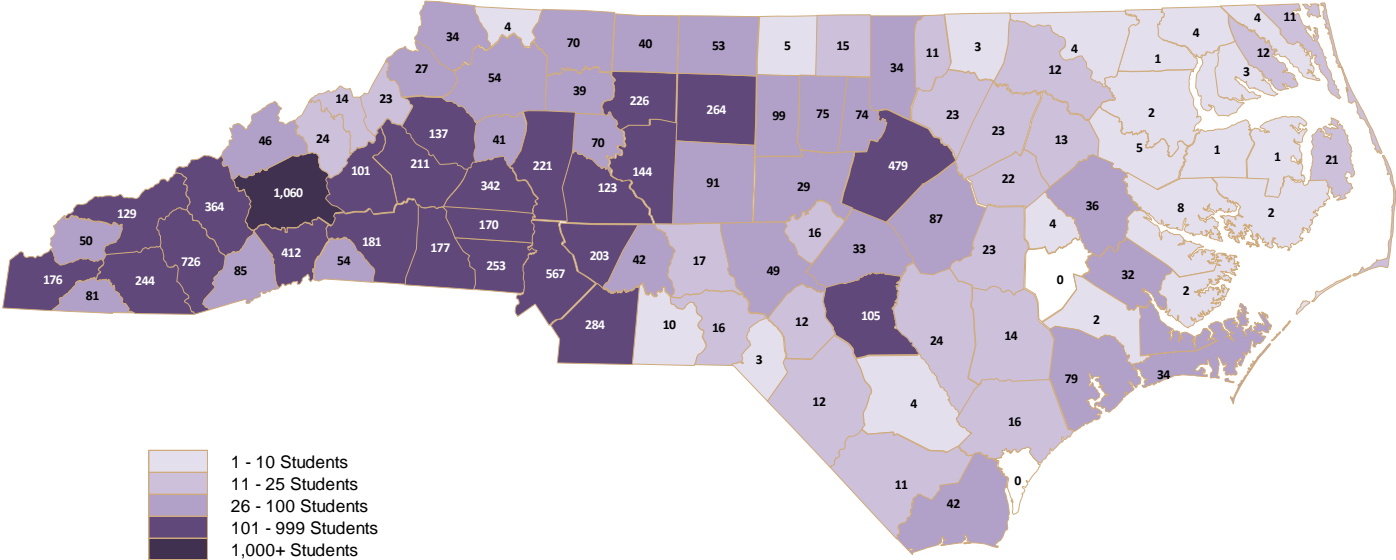

# Geographic Distribution of Students

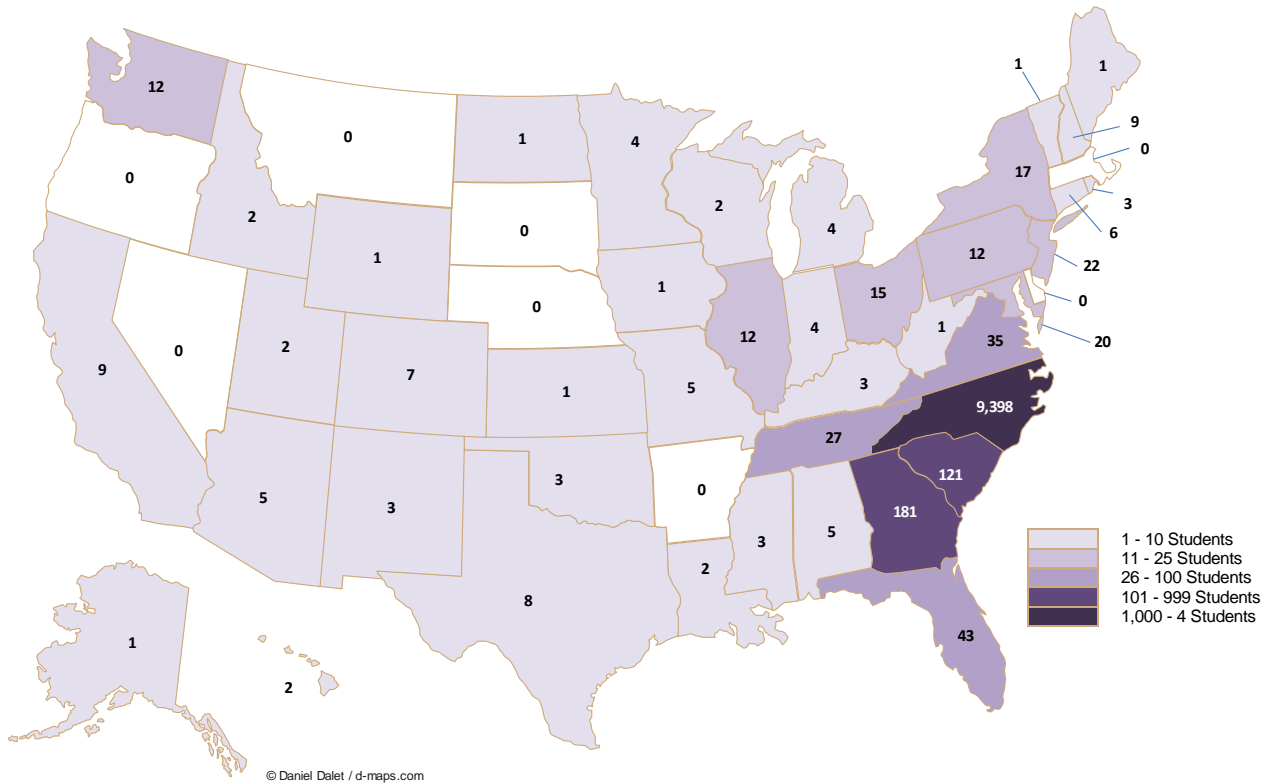

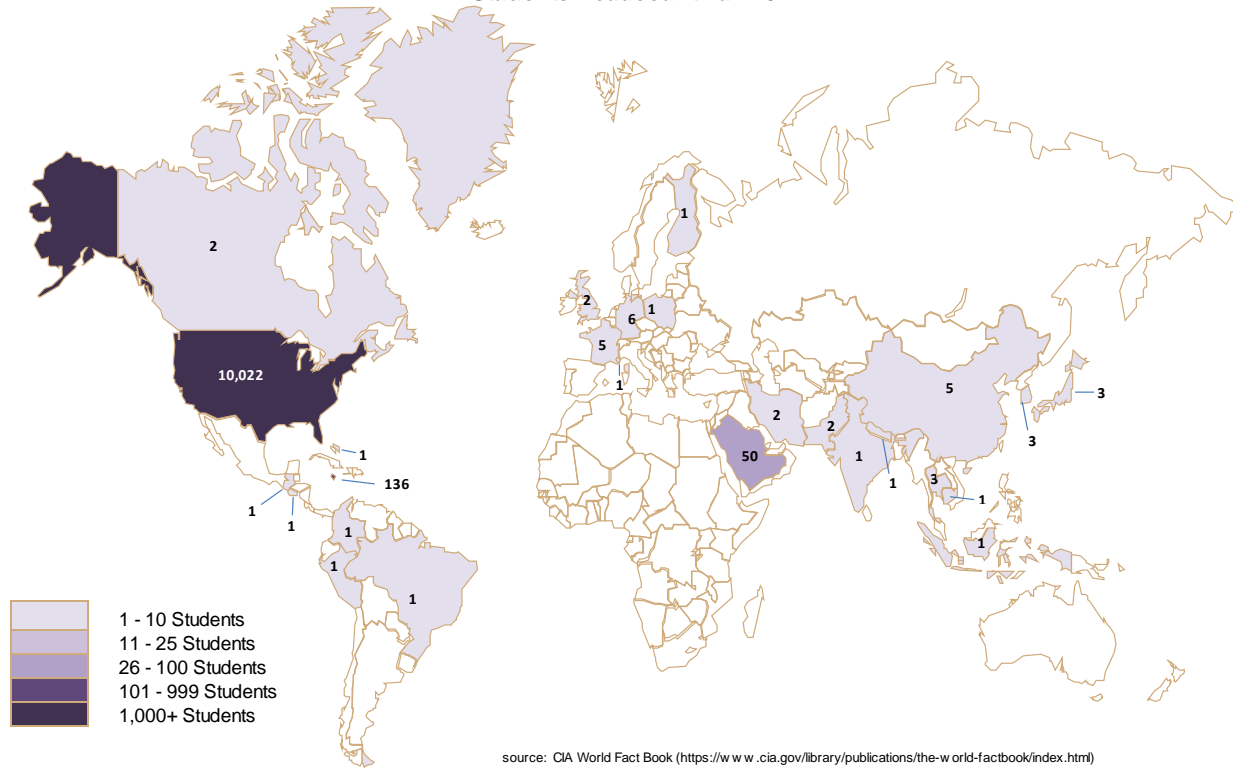
