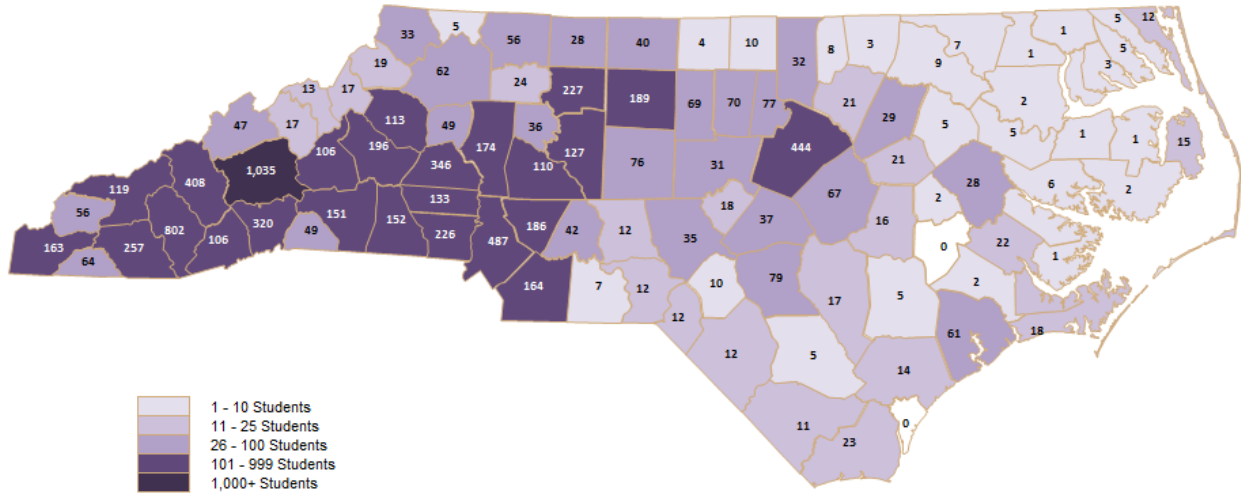

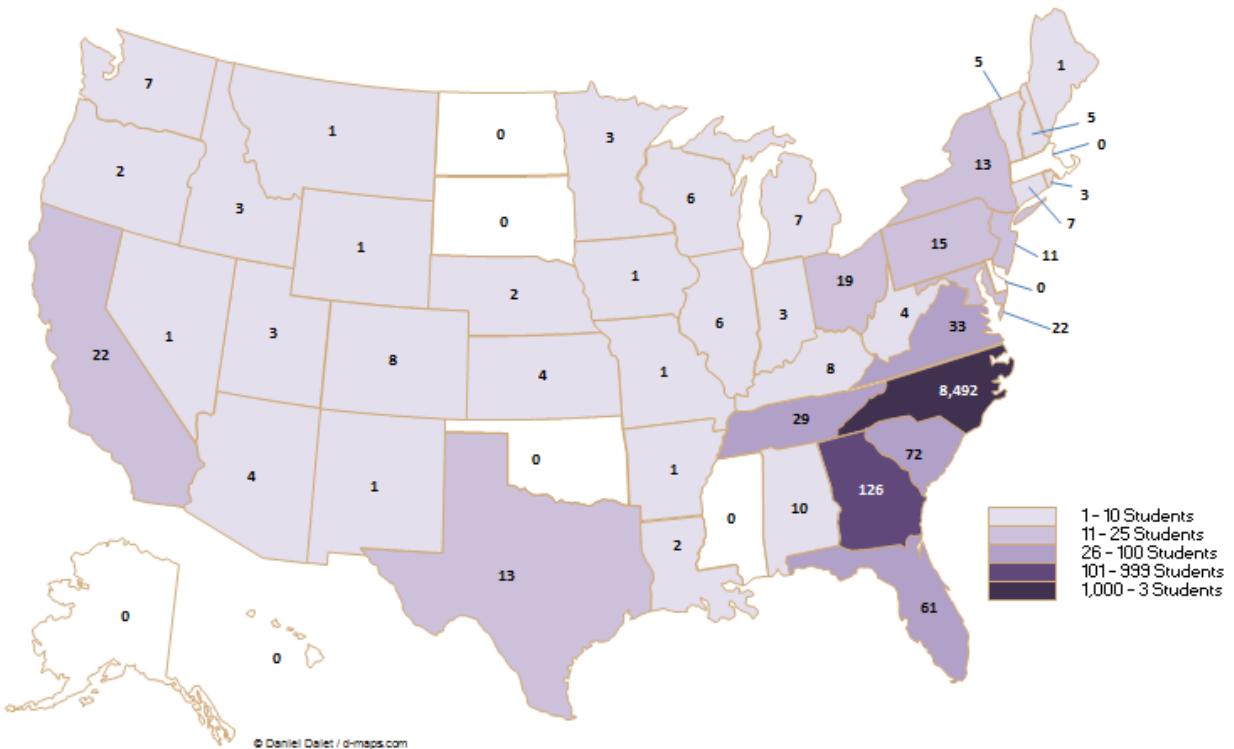

# Geographic Distribution of All Students

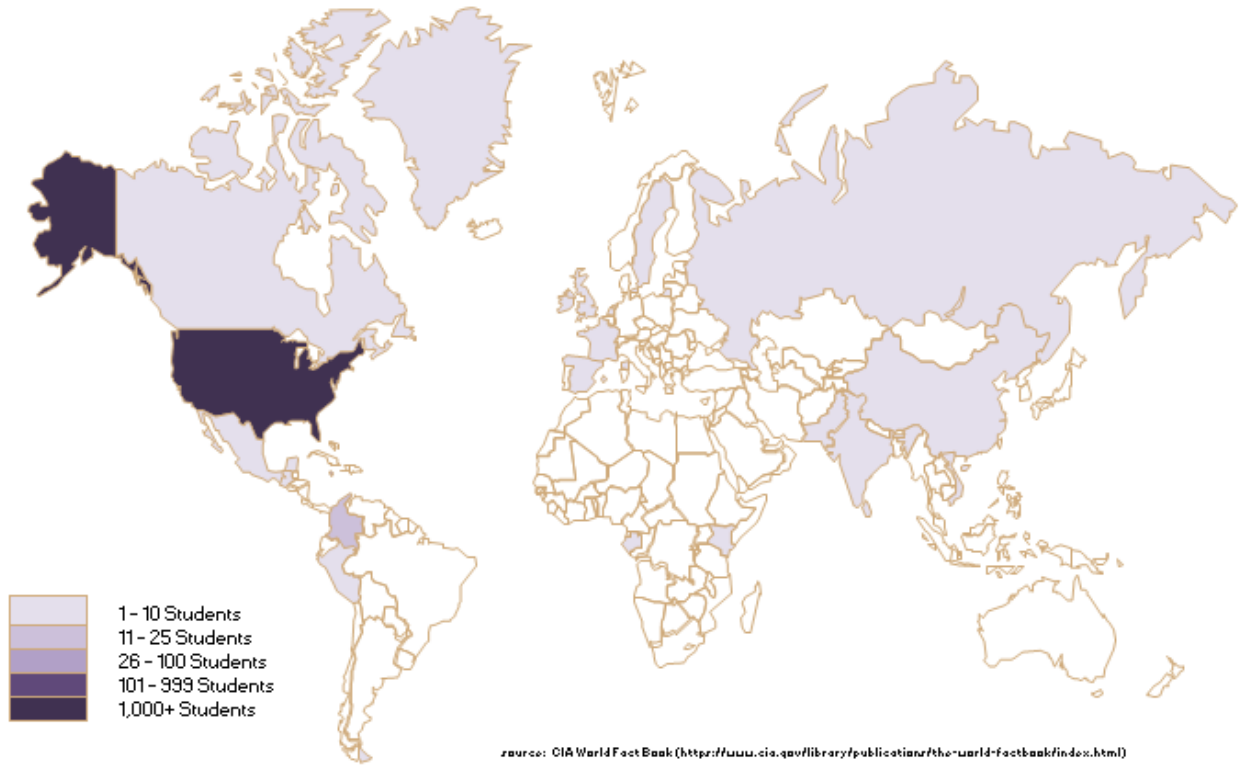
## In State
